- * a new fillable Subscription form has been created. Subscriptions should be paid to Branch Bank Account. Database will be updated by Ash Holmes.
- * Visitors fees need to be collected at every Branch Meeting: honesty box and notice to be prominently displayed for non-members to pay.

*The committee discussed the creation of a “Steve Rogers Award” in memory of a well-respected member. It was agreed that trophy will be created and awarded annually at the AGM to a non-committee member who has made a significant contribution to the branch programme.
